For <b>self-employment</b> : Information regarding the company and financing (e.g. location
offer, business plan, credit and financial information, business contacts in Germany)
Detailed job description from your future employer
Form "Erklärung zum Beschäftigungsverhältnis", filled out and stamped by your employer
University degree (original + 1 copy) AND Anabin printout of degree and university
equivalent (see https://anabin.kmk.org/anabin.html). If applicable: certified translation
into German or English
Proof of accommodation in Germany with full address (e.g. rental contract, hotel
reservation) OR invitation letter in case of private accommodation with name, full address
and their passport/ID copy
Proof of health insurance cover – may be submitted later on, after the visa application has
been approved
